

Rules for Student-Athletes

1. During a sport season, any student/participant, found to be in personal possession of or found to be using alcohol, tobacco, and/or other illegal drugs, by a USD 473 Faculty/Staff member, by Law Enforcement Personnel, or by personal admission will be disciplined as follows.

1st Offense--suspension from team for a minimum of 1 competition and will miss 5 days of practice.

2nd Offense--dismissal for the remainder of the season and will automatically be ready for this step 2 for any other sport season while in high school at CHS.

2. No student/participant shall behave with unsportsmanlike conduct. Any such behavior will result in a conference with the Coach, Athletic Director, and possibly the Principal. Penalty could vary up to suspension for the remainder of the season.
3. On away games student/participant will ride to and from the game on the bus provided by the school, unless the athlete has a signed note from their parents of their parents ask permission of the coach to have their son/daughter ride home with them after the contest. Notes should be given to the coach prior to leaving on the trip.
4. No student/participant should miss practice without excuse. If it is unexcused by the head coach, the 1st offense will result in a conference with the head coach. The penalty will to be decided by the head coach. The 2nd offense will result in the athlete not playing in the next contest for which he/she is eligible. The 3rd offense will be dismissal from the squad. No student/participant should miss contests without excuse. Unexcused by the head coach will result in suspension of at least one contest and a conference with the possibility of dismissal.
5. The first 4 rules are mandatory for all sports. Other training rules may be added by individual coaches for their sport with the approval of the Athletic Director or Principal.
