Arrival & Dismissal Reminders

Blue Ridge: 7:50 AM – 3:25 PM
STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING UNTIL 7:50 AM, as staff are not available for supervision of your child(ren). For the safety of all students, please do not park in front of the school, our bus drivers need the circle drive to pick up and drop off students.

Breakfast and Lunch Payments

If your child is eating school lunches we ask that you pay by the month in advance. If your child's account reaches \$0.00, parents are requested to add to their child's account balance. Please see the student handbook or call the office for questions you may have regarding meal fees.

Board of Education Policy

Guidelines for Delinquent Payments

"Payments for school lunches are to be made in a timely manner. If lunch payments are delinquent for 2 days for grades 9-12 or 5 days for grades K-8, future hot lunches and/or milk will be denied to the student. The parent/student will be responsible for providing payment for hot lunches and/or breakfast. There will be no notification of delinquency from the building principal."

Enrollment Fees

If you have not paid enrollment fees for your child, please submit your payment by Friday, September 6th. If you need to set up a payment plan, please contact the office by this date. Thank You!

Reminders from the Office

***Your child's take home folder is a vital part of communication between you, your child and his or her teacher. PLEASE CHECK IT EVERY DAY as there may be information that needs to be returned in a timely manner.**
