Weather Guidelines

As the cooler weather approaches, here are a few reminders of our cold weather guidelines.

***Please see that your child is dressing appropriately for cooler weather with long sleeve shirts and long pants. This will also include wearing shoes with socks.**

***Students need to wear jackets/coats when the outdoor temperature is 50 degrees or lower. A hoodie is not a jacket that will block wind, nor is it a coat.**

***If the wind chill temperature is 20 degrees or lower, students will have an indoor recess.**

Physical activity, fresh air, and playing outside are a part of your child's school day. Hats, gloves, scarves, etc., will help keep them warm.
