Mike Rutz made a motion to add an Executive Session for Personnel as Item #9 and then to adopt the Agenda. Brenda Edleston seconded the motion; motion carried 7-0.

April Swartz from Varney & Associates gave an overview of their audit they conducted this fall of our 2019 financial records. Both she and Jerry agreed the process went very smoothly. This was their 1st year as our auditing firm due to Mize Houser and Associates deciding to no longer audit school districts. Varney took over most of their clientele. She reported that there were no cash violations and that no funds exceeded our budget. We had no violations at all.

Kelly Kuntz made the motion to approve the presented list of early graduates pending successful completion of all requirements. Brian Rock seconded the motion; motion carried 7-0.

Mike Rutz made the motion to accept the bid from Hellas Construction for the Track Project at \$725,000, with the understanding the final cost could come in under that amount. Jerry Wright seconded the motion; motion carried 7-0.

<u>Covid update</u>: Jerry said he and Tara and Jodi have been working on getting a dashboard added to the district website showing the number of Covid cases we have. It will update every Monday and Friday. It's located on the USD 473 website.

The Board discussed with Jerry several scenarios and Jerry feels confident that if Dr. Holmes has to do this again, it will no longer be a recommendation only to the County schools and he will just shut down the District or County, period. If we don't reconvene face-to-face on January 4th, that will likely mean numbers have risen greatly and this time, Dr. Holmes will do a mandatory closing and we will have no say in it.

Kelly did request and Brenda agreed, that if we have to close again the Board feels there needs to be a meeting with them prior to the shutdown and announcement. Even if it's on a weekend, or even if it can only be a Zoom meeting, they would like to meet before that action takes place.

Mike Rutz made the motion to approve the personnel items that were presented. Jerry Wright seconded the motion; motion carried 7-0.
