Kyle Cook presented a technology proposal on what it would take to make the Board Room at the Education Center ready for remote meetings. He had a quote for right under \$20,000.00. Dr. Frieze asked if we could consider putting that money into possibly the High School so that the students could take advantage of an audio/video room as well. This will be revisited at a later date. For now, Board meetings will continue to be held in the High School Auditorium.

Track Update – Superintendent Hodson gave an update on where we are at with the track. Hellas Construction will be out on Friday to survey it. We should see significant progress mid July. An 8 lane track was brought up but after getting the figures, it would not be cost effective for us so we will stick with a 7 lane track. The tentative completion for the track is mid August. Todd Frieze said a 7 lane track is perfectly acceptable; however, we need to do something about the visitor's bleachers. They need to be moved back from the track and we need fencing in order to keep people off the track during football games.
