Following  
Exposure to  
COVID-19:

The close contact CAN  
PROVIDE MEDICAL  
DOCUMENTATION of  
having contracted  
COVID-19 or having  
received a COVID-19  
vaccination:

NO in-school  
quarantine  
required

NO at-home  
quarantine  
required

Mask  
recommended.  
Monitor for  
symptoms, if  
symptoms  
develop testing  
required.

The close contact CAN  
NOT PROVIDE MEDICAL  
DOCUMENTATION of  
having contracted  
COVID-19 or having  
received a COVID-19  
vaccination:

Parental  
Choice  
of:

In-school  
quarantine  
ONLY allowed  
IF:

7 or 10 day  
at-home  
quarantine

- Daily testing for 7 days.
- Wear a mask for at least 7 days from their last exposure.
- Additional social distancing.
- Limited participation in high-risk activities.
- Remain asymptomatic.

The close contact CAN  
NOT PROVIDE MEDICAL  
DOCUMENTATION of  
having contracted  
COVID-19 or having  
received a COVID-19  
vaccination  
BUT was wearing a mask:

Student can  
remain in school if  
they continue to  
wear a mask and  
remain  
asymptomatic.
